L.E. Modesitt, Jr.'s Saga of Recluce is an intricate blend of magic and technology on a world where Chaos and Order, and the full spectrum that falls between them,



are the keys to great power...and great peril. *Colors of Chaos* is the second book about the White Chaos wizards who have, through the ages, opposed the magicians of Recluce. In this ninth volume of the Saga of Recluce, available in paperback for the first time this January, the wizard Cerryl (introduced in *The White Order*) has become a full mage among the White brethren of Fairhaven. But, as he rises through the ranks of the Order he must be careful to shield his Black powers so completely that no one suspects he is a Gray mage. When his old enemy Jeslek becomes High Wizard, Cerryl must find a way to make himself indispensable to the Order, in battle or intrigue, to claim the honors that he covets. But, even with the aid of his love, the Black healer Leyladin, it's no easy task to counter the seductive wiles of deadly, Chaos-wielding Anya ...and survive the many other hazards that surround him. Recluce fans should watch for the new hard-cover, *Magi'i of Cyador*, coming this March.
